

Church with a Capital "C"

We declare, All are welcome. No matter your Identification... Orientation... Declaration... Situation... Qualification... There is no question, You are beloved. Still, we stand, unsatisfied by the unchanging Church. Saying Dignity is the minimum, when humanity is the question. Because human rights are not up for debate in the spaces that we make. But while building a new normal, It's easy to forget that I'm a part of the Church with a capital "C". The same Church that chooses to erase me. The Church that tells me that modest is hottest and how to submit. To be happy with the scraps, 'cause at least I have a seat. You see... The system is not made for a queer woman like me. I have a list of "sins" I've committed longer than a CVS receipt. Martin Luther might have had 95 complaints, but I have a thousand more of the ways the Church has failed to open their doors. The Church with a capital "C" claims to do no harm, yet they do not recognize me and how my faith becomes something I flee, because I refuse to believe in the Church with a capital "C". In my dissent, I acknowledge that I am a part of a church within the Church with a capital "C". To live in that church bubble is ignorant while the harm is astronomical. But to fight from within, there's a lot of red tape. All while I kneel on the altar with my heart agape. I did not get here by chance, no, it was by faith. This is a fight I did not want to begin, but now it is a fight we must win. So I start with the promise to "do no harm" and to lead in this church with a capital "C", in my most authentic decree. To be gueer, and to acknowledge I question my gender. To lead in my crop top, and let my youth wear bikinis. To acknowledge the Bible is complex, how scripture has been weaponized. To remember how we have been baptized. I even vow to help the Church with a capital "C" reconcile this harm they cause me. But today, as I wait, and the wounds are still fresh, and I haven't gone numb... I will send love to the Church with a capital "C" with a simple plea: Recognize... Restore... Reconcile.... Only then can we begin to Revive, because the Church is what must change. Not me.
