

LUKE 14:1, 7-14

Divine hostility, even in some of these disconcerting portrayals, is reserved for the powerful who uphold, enforce, and reproduce the brutality of domination. So we are wise to lower ourselves in solidarity with those forced to the bottom lest we are among God's accused.
