

Unisex/family restrooms are accessible from the narthex, to the left as you exit the sanctuary.

The balcony is open for those wishing to have more social distancing.

Holy Communion is typically celebrated on the first Sunday of the month.

Masks are required while on campus at Allendale to protect the most vulnerable.



JEREMIAH 23:1-6

The prophets are those called to remind us that we must live in at least two realms at once. The prophetic is a place of endings and apocalypses. The prophetic is a space of destruction and decomposition as much as it is one of germination and renewal. We are not to be seduced by the illusion of stability that has imperiled us. By the words of the prophet, we recall that our exile is yet another weakened link to the chains that have us bound to a dystopian reality. This does not make our exile worthwhile, but it can offer us hope in the midst of a sea of violence.
