

#### **CELEBRATE BLACK HISTORY:**




Martin Luther King Jr. (1929-1968) was a minister and activist, one of the most prominent leaders in the civil rights movement.

King is remembered for his masterful oratorical skills, most memorably in his "I Have a Dream" speech. His adoption of nonviolent resistance to achieve equal rights for Black Americans earned him the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964.

MLK is often sanitized and used by predominantly white orgs and corporations to further a false unity. In contrast, the real King spoke hard truths against war, capitalism, and the white moderate...

"I have almost reached the regrettable conclusion that the Negro's great stumbling block in the stride toward freedom is not the White Citizens Councilor or the Ku Klux Klanner but the White moderate who is more devoted to 'order' than to justice."



Audre Lorde (1934-1991) was an American writer, womanist, radical feminist, professor, and civil rights activist.

She was a self-described "black, lesbian, mother, warrior, poet," who "dedicated both her life and her creative talent to confronting and addressing injustices of racism, sexism, classism, and homophobia."
