CELEBRATE BLACK HISTORY:



Maya Angelou (1928-2014) was an author, actress, screenwriter, dancer, poet, and civil rights activist best known for her 1969 memoir, I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings, which made literary history as the first nonfiction bestseller by an African American woman.

She spent about five years in silence following a traumatic childhood experience. She wrote 36 books and was the first black San Francisco cable car operator.

"If you don't like something, change it. If you can't change it, change your attitude."



James Baldwin (1924-1987) was a writer and civil rights activist who is best known for his semiautobiographical novels and plays that center on race, politics, and sexuality.

Baldwin's work fictionalizes fundamental personal questions and dilemmas amid complex social and psychological pressures. Themes of masculinity, sexuality, race, and class intertwine to create intricate narratives that run parallel with some of the major political movements toward social change in mid-twentieth century America, such as the civil rights movement and the gay liberation movement. Characters in Baldwin's work often face internal and external obstacles in their search for social and selfacceptance.
