

CELEBRATE BLACK HISTORY:



Harriet Tubman (1822-1913) was an abolitionist and social activist. To share her story, here's an excerpt from the children's book "Before She Was Harriet" written by Lesa Cline-Ransome. This book is banned in some Florida schools, which we think is ridiculous. We read the book during Time With Children in church last Sunday.

"Remember her days as a suffragist, as a general, as a spy, as a nurse, as Aunt Harriet, as Moses, as a conductor, as Minty, as Araminta, who dreamed of living long enough, to one day be old, stiff and achy, tired and worn and wrinkled, and free."



Bayard Rustin (1912 – 1987) is one of the most pivotal figures in the Black Civil Rights movement but was kept out of the public spotlight because he was a gay man.

In 2013, Rustin was posthumously awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom. "Bayard Rustin was an unyielding activist for civil rights, dignity, and equality for all. An advisor to the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., he promoted nonviolent resistance, participated in one of the first Freedom Rides, organized the 1963 March on Washington for Jobs and Freedom, and fought tirelessly for marginalized communities at home and abroad. As an openly gay African American, Mr. Rustin stood at the intersection of several of the fights for equal rights."

Some conspiracy theorists like to reinterpret classic extraordinary Bible stories as some sort of psychoactive drug-induced hallucination. I don't know if anyone was influenced by ancient hallucinogens in the Bible, and I typically find that oversimplified explanation to be very naive. However, if any story could be reinterpreted that way, then the Transfiguration is a top contender.

Oftentimes these mountaintop experiences can knock us into new ways of perceiving the world, which is something we desperately need if we want to change it. And we don't necessarily need drugs to stretch our imaginations this far.
