

WOODSON WARRIORS SCHOLARSHIP:

Last Sunday, One City Chorus held a fundraiser concert at Allendale to befenit the Woodson Warriors scholarship fund, raising \$3,477.

The program now supports 40 scholars who are eligible to recieve \$5000 each year of college for a total of \$20,000.

Scholars are attending schools in Florida, New York, Boston, and Georgia, majoring in aerospace engineering, international affairs, musical theatre, psycology, business administration, nursing, and more. The first class of Woodson Warriors are graduating the spring.

Applicants must have at least a 3.0 GPA, be residents of St. Pete, and have at least one African American parent.

PSALM 116

Have you ever been through a tough season in your life... and didn't realize it until later? Delayed grief is normal. It is so normal that most people experience some sort of delayed grief response in their lifetime. As the cliche goes, "healing is not linear." Neither is grief. We may think we're fine after a day or two off of work, but then on the way to the office, we start crying after seeing an ad of a dog who looks like the one we just buried.

Many mental health professionals encourage grieving people to reach out. Whether inwardly through journaling or outwardly through grief support groups, finding some way to name what we feel is healthy. It is no accident, then, that so many religious rituals involve the transformation of solo-grief into community bonds.
