

JOHN 14:15-21

Commandments work when enforced by powerful authorities, yet our faith tradition starts with a disobeyed command leading to oppression. This disobedience to a divine command, set up as a cosmic power play, marks humanity's entry into the Christian narrative. Unlike God's use of power, Jesus, being human, resorts to loving arguments instead of coercion. His teachings reframe our understanding of divine authority, proposing a shift towards love. Jesus introduces a commandment of unconditional love, which identifies us with the Divine Love. This love commandment can revolutionize hypermasculine and sacred concepts, freeing them from societal expectations, leading to a more liberated application of faith.
