

MATTHEW 9:35-10:8, (9-23)

Much of Jesus's ministry was a rhythm of staying, eating, and healing wherever he went, and Jesus teaches this rhythm to his disciples. As he sends out his first missionaries, it wasn't about a new religious conversion, or reeducation, or some sort of ancient multi-level marketing scheme. This was about building interdependent communities that we see continue through the book of Acts. And this mission is the kin-dom of God.

While other countercultural movements based their resistance on teaching people to live a life of selfsufficiency Jesus's movement based their resistance on building communities of interdependency. This type of counterculture doesn't further atomize, but further communalizes as a subversive action.
