

TODAY'S LITURGIST:

DR. BOB WALLACE (he/him/his) was born in Ohio, moved here in 1972, and went at Northeast High, St. Petersburg Junior College, and FSU. He continued to the University of Florida College of Medicine, and did his residency at Bayfront Medical Center. Bob has provided medical care to the St. Pete community for 41 years. He is one of the first doctors willing to treat HIV/AIDS patients, and helped develop special medication for them. Bob is known locally as an expert in HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis C treatments, and focuses on eliminating Hepatitis C at his clinic, Love the Golden Rule, Inc. He's been attending Allendale since the mid-1990s.

GIRLS ROCK CAMP:

Each summer, 40 local campers ages 8-17 gather to learn rock instruments. They form bands, write original songs and after just one week, they perform their songs to hundreds of fans at Jannus Live.

Last year was the first year Girls Rock Camp met at Allendale. Next week (July 17-21) they'll be using almost every inch of the campus. Girls Rock camp is open to all girls, non-binary, and gender-expansive youth, especially Black and brown young people in St. Pete, and their programming is explicitly feminist, anti-racist with a focus on uplifting Black and brown young folks and people of non-dominant genders.

WARREN WILLIS CAMP: This week, Theresa and our students were at Warren Willis Camp in Fruitland Park, FL. Situated on beautiful Lake Griffin and surrounded by nature, the United Methodist Camp gives students opportunities for spiritual development, team building, and outdoor

Campers get to experience time away from home and away from their normal routines. They can sign up for special elective activities during the week such as Sailing, Canoeing, Ceramics, Cooking, Disk Golf,

Although campers usually spend a lot of time with their friends and church group, scripture-based curriculum is done in randomly assigned small groups that give students an opportunity to meet others in their age group. This small group goes through a ropes course and other teambuilding exercises which has created friendships between people who would have otherwise never met.

Campers come home with a greater sense of independence, autonomy, and confidence, backed by new relationships formed in a loving and affirming place.

The impact of Warren Willis Camp extends far beyond the camp itself. It fosters long-lasting, connectional relationships within the broader United Methodist Church community all across Florida.

ROMANS 7:15-25A

In this passage, Paul talks about the struggle between what he wants to do and what he ends up doing. Despite his best intentions, he sometimes acts against his own desires. It's like there's a force within him, pushing him towards actions that he doesn't agree with, and he feels powerless against it. Despite his mind knowing what's right, his body seems to have a different agenda, leaving him feeling trapped.

Paul is describing a very human experience— the battle between what we know is right or good for us and the sometimes overpowering urge to do the opposite. His frustration and self-questioning are feelings that most of us can relate to at some point in our lives.
