

### WITNESS

### YOU'VE SEARCHED ME AND KNOW ME:

Imagine God. What does God look like? What kind of expression does God have on God's face? Does God have a face? Does it look like yours? What face does God make when you do something good? What face does God make when you make a mistake?

For many of us, religious trauma shapes each of these answers. In fact, given Christian hegemony, we might argue that everyone is in some way shaped negatively by some punitive, scary, surveilling depiction of God. God has been imagined as a figure who always knows what we're up to. And not only does God know what we're up to, God is judging us the whole time.

Perhaps, it can be healing to imagine God as a loving teacher. Certainly, not all teachers are loving, but if we are lucky, we all can think of one teacher who was kind and generous towards us. In this Psalm, the psalmist describes all the best attributes of a good teacher. Someone who knows when we sit down and rise up, who knows our thoughts, who knows our ways, who can anticipate the words we'll say, who lay a loving hand on our shoulders for encouragement. Our most loving teacher is always around, knows everything, and meets us everywhere. There's never room for us to get bored because we are challenged with appropriate assignments. There is joy around us everywhere. And most importantly, the best teachers advocate for us and know our character. They make room for us and hold us accountable to the best versions of ourselves.

As we read this Psalm, we can challenge ourselves to create a loving God who wants joy and liberation for us and equips us to meet the moments of our lives. In creating this God, that God becomes real.

We can hope that this God has a bigger footprint than the God who has done harm. -Min. Candace Simpson

PSALM 139:1-12, 23-24

Dr. Seuss' "Horton Hears A Who" has often been co-opted by anti-abortion activists utilizing Horton's refrain "A person's a person, no matter how small" to justify their stance. Audrey Geisel, Dr. Seuss' widow, has expressed discomfort at her husband's work being utilized to push a particular viewpoint. Despite the challenges and potential repercussions faced by those seeking abortion care in many U.S. states, a comparison to the biblical concept of Sheol (the realm of the dead), we are reminded that we are never truly alone - God is ever-present, even during our most trying times. We are urged to invite God, mentors, and systems of accountability to search our hearts and guide us, surrendering to the possibility of being wrong and being open to course corrections, all of which foster a more honest and spiritually aligned life.
