

MATTHEW 14:13-21

Jesus is trying to get a little alone-time here, and the guy just can't get a break. He has just received news of the statesponsored murder of his mentor and friend, John, called the Baptist, and whether from grief or fear for his own life, his impulse is to withdraw to a deserted place, to spend some time listening to the still, small voice that speaks through stones and mountains and muddy waters and the mouths of caves.

The deserted place is, of course, where John did his radical work, inviting us out of the centers of commerce, where the dominant culture continually recruits us into service of the imperial status quo, and into the wilderness where it is easier to remember that none of this actually belongs to Rome, least of all our own lives, minds, and souls. Scripturally, the wilderness is the province of free people who are remembering they are free.
