WITNESS

The Journey Toward A Church For All:

Adapted from the Author's Note published in "A Church for All," which is the book being read for today's Time With Children.

Years ago, a friend encouraged me to attend a service at a unique church, and I was VERY reluctant. Raised in a church that was not accepting of LGBTQ+ people, as an adult, I struggled to find a spiritual community where all people, including those in the LGBTQ+ community, like myself, were welcome.

However, this church was different. My friend, who is a lesbian, said "You'll love it, and "It's a rock-your-world-experience". It did, in fact, rock my world! For the first time, I had found a spiritual community that fully accepted and embraced LGBTQ+ people. That's the feeling I wanted to capture in "A *Church for All.*"

Since the mid-20th century, that church has been known for its commitment to civil rights and social justice, especially serving the urban community. It became a pioneering site for dialogue on LGBTQ+ issues and has been performing same-sex marriages as an act of justice since the 1990s. The church's choir also became a symbol of diversity, acceptance, and love.

Today, many churches around the country have embraced the vision of inclusivity. They are often called "*Inclusive Churches*" or "*Open and Affirming Churches*". Many indicate their commitment with banners featuring a rainbow flag or slogans like "All Are Welcome."

The spirit of this mission has greatly inspired me, and I'm grateful to all spiritual communities across the globe, from every denomination, that welcome, accept, embrace, and celebrate us for who we are.

ISAIAH 56:1-8

Today's Scripture helps us understand how we can take seriously the complex work of reconciliation. We seek unity with one another which is not to be misconstrued for sameness. Reconciliation is the dance of community - a commitment to co-creation through conflict.
