

Changing table is available in the Nursery.

Unisex/family restrooms are accessible from the narthex, to the left as you exit the sanctuary.

The balcony is open for those wishing to have more social distancing.

Holy Communion is typically celebrated on the first Sunday of the month.


COLD NIGHT SHELTER:

Powerless in the face of a malevolent force (parent, nation, system) that is larger than us—then? now? always?—all we can hear is the sarcastic snarl: "Where is that God who supposedly cares about you? What can all your talk of love and community care and mutual aid do for you now?"

But the present is actually not all there is. There is a past, and there is a future. The memory of being held in community can lead us to the place where love dwells, to the holy altar of all that is tender and true.
