

YOU ARE A CHILD OF GOD!:



Freedom fighters in The United Methodist Church have been in a 52 year-long marathon to exorcize the phrase "homosexuality is incompatible with Christian teaching" from our Discipline. Today these evil words in ¶161 have been vanquished!

It was not a race anyone could run alone, but a relay race of courageous individuals who sacrificed everything. Queer heroes (queeroes) alongside allies passed the baton over the course of 13 worldwide gatherings (General Conferences) where the harm to LGBTQ people got exponentially worse.

Some who ran hard are not with us in person at this finish line. Many have died, some have needed to take rest from the toxicity, but all have passed the baton to this moment-a great cloud of witnesses. This General Conference has thrown off everything that hinders and the sin of discrimination that entangles.

The quote on our sign from Nelson Mandela, a Methodist, is a prophetic vision of the hope and endurance required to do big things like end apartheid. It will continue to be our call as we move forward to struggle for justice. We reached a finish line today, but this is a race that keeps going until all are free!
