MARK 3:20-35

We know that doubt and skepticism can play major roles in our lives as they can in our scriptural texts. We are shown vignettes and portrayals of incredibly strong communities grappling with how to find truth in thick vapor of uncertainty. Certainty doesn't always have to be our goal. Perhaps truth is something that transcends certainty. Perhaps where we think ourselves most secure is really where we can exercise the most control. When we join together, voicing our doubts and uncertainties in community, we can become a force of solidarity strong enough to topple empires. We can become feared by the powerful that have terrorized us. Our questions are not antithetical to justice.
