

2 CORINTHIANS 8:7-15

The first Pride marches were held on June 28, 1970, marking the one-year anniversary of the Stonewall Uprising.

Thousands of LGBTQIA+ people gathered to commemorate Stonewall and demand equal rights, making invisibility no longer an option. Within a few years, gay rights organizations were founded worldwide.

The first Pride Sunday at a church occurred in the early 1970s, soon after the Stonewall riots. Both Pride and worship are acts of celebration and protest, remembrance, and inclusion.

On Pride Sunday, we cry out for justice, celebrate our embodied selves, and honor those who came before us. Pride Sunday celebrates the image of God in everyone and the diversity of humanity.
