

Gender Pronouns: Asking and correctly using someone's preferred pronoun is one of the most basic ways to show your respect for their gender identity. When someone is referred to with the wrong pronoun, it can do harm.

Childcare/Nursery: Located in the courtyard, the first room to the right as you leave the sanctuary building. Children are welcomed and encouraged to stay in worship, even if they are noisy! The nursery is available beginning at 10 AM for children younger than kindergarten.

Unisex/family restrooms are in the office hallway, accessible from the narthex, to the left as you exit the sanctuary.

The balcony is open for those wishing to have more social distancing.

EXODUS 16:2-4, 9-15

We don't always know how to keep the faith. It may seem like God is taking the scenic route. We may believe that God is choosing to answer everyone else's prayers first, and this can tempt us to take matters into our own hands. We may begin to devise our own schemes using our own power to get what we want. We may abuse our positions and misuse our influence to manifest our desires on our terms. Perhaps the answer was with us all along. Perhaps we can turn to one another for security we didn't think we had. Maybe the bread from heaven is coming from someone whose parents we know, and we just have to believe that we deserve it. Maybe we have provision and mercy to last the day and keep our hearts clean. Relying on the Divine doesn't mean we sit back, wait, and do nothing. Relying on the Divine means that we turn to our community to discuss how we'll get through.
