

EPHESIANS 6:10-20

Everything is a competition. It seems the gods must go head to head, we disciples need to be clad with full armor, powers and principalities are conspiring towards our demise. We may worry that our faith is militaristic - that we've been drafted in to cause even more pain. Wise peoples know the horror of having to take up arms to defend your people and land. Oppressed peoples know that diplomacy is consent to the oppressor. Rudimentary rockets cannot stop behemoth bombs, and our trauma has PTSD of its own, your god is trying to un-create us, and we have nothing to lose but our chains. Pacifism is beautiful, but deadly when the gun is always pointing at you. If we refuse to die on a blood-soaked moral high ground, then they can call us flesh eaters and blood-drinkers.

Maybe we'll prove them right.
