GALATIANS 5:22-23 & UPWARD!: PP. 55-56 This passage describes the fruits of the Spirit—qualities like love, joy, peace, and kindness that emerge in us as we live by the Spirit. In the Wesleyan tradition, understanding our faith through the lens of wonder begins with appreciating the grandeur of God's creation. Every person is made in God's image and is deeply loved by God. Yet, despite this divine image, we encounter brokenness and alienation in our relationships with God and others. The Wesleyan dialogue on redemption shows how God liberates and reconciles us amidst this brokenness, sustaining us through the journey with grace-filled means. As we explore the Wesleyan views on sustenance and restoration, we see how God's intention for fullness and restoration in our lives invites us to a state of gratitude and renewal.
