

WITNESS

CHRIS ANDERSON'S STORY:

We believe that everyone's story holds transformative power. Today, we're sharing Chris Anderson's journey of faith, identity, and self-love—a story that resonates with our mission of radical inclusion.

Growing up in a religious household, Chris was taught that being queer was wrong. Yet, from a young age, he knew they were different. When caught expressing this by a grandparent, Chris was told they would go to hell, leaving them ashamed and fearful. In high school, Chris tried to conform and hide his crushes on girls, but the fear of rejection pushed them further away from church.

College offered Chris a chance to meet people who accepted them as they were. But returning home still meant hiding their true self. In 2022, Chris created a short film celebrating their queerness and decided to come out to their family. To his surprise, their family responded with love, teaching Chris about self-acceptance.

"If my family, rooted in a homophobic church, could love me, why wouldn't Jesus?" Chris reflects. "Why would God create me like this for it to be wrong?" Now, Chris is preparing for top surgery to feel more at home in his body and is seeking support to make this next step possible.

Chris's story reminds us that God's love is not bound by fear or rejection. If you feel moved to support, consider donating to their surgery fund. Together, we can be a community that embodies Christ's love and support.

MATTHEW 26:20-30 & UPWARD!: PP. 162-163

In this passage, Jesus shares the Passover meal with his disciples, symbolically introducing the new covenant through his body and blood. This moment of intimacy and impending sacrifice underscores a profound act of love and inclusion, mirroring the essence of servanthood and sacrifice. By emulating Jesus—who emptied himself of all but love and welcomed everyone into a sacred space we too can break down barriers and build bridges toward a restored and just world. This dual narrative of Jesus' actions and our call to action invites us to transform our communities through practices that reflect divine love and foster beloved community. In this way, the scripture and your reflections urge us to live out our faith by actively participating in God's vision of shalom, healing, and holistic restoration.
