ACTS 2:42-47

As a clergyperson, I strive to ensure that ALL are welcome in faith spaces. It's heartbreaking when churches unintentionally prevent people from fully participating. My aunt, who was diagnosed with Celiac disease eight years ago, has only been able to safely receive Communion three times. Being excluded from such a core ritual has caused her deep grief.

This image, *Open Table*, is a reflection on what a more inclusive Table could be. At the center are the elements of Communion: bread and wine. The light of Christ radiates from the bread, reaching the hands of those ready to receive, without barriers.

Surrounding the image are plants that provide gluten-free ingredients buckwheat, amaranth, quinoa, millet, and sorghum—symbolizing Christ's everexpanding welcome and the abundance of ways we can ensure everyone has a place in worship and at the Table. —Rev. Lauren Wright Pittman
