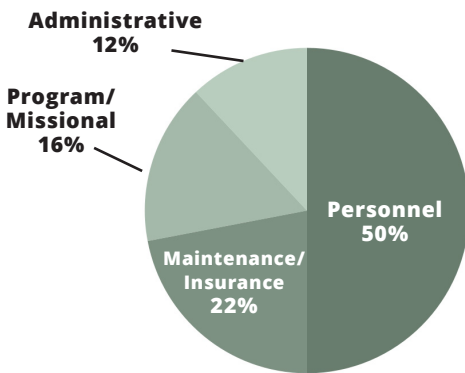
PLEDGE FOR 2025 GENERAL OPERATING:

This is what you plan to give to support our general operating budget over the next year.

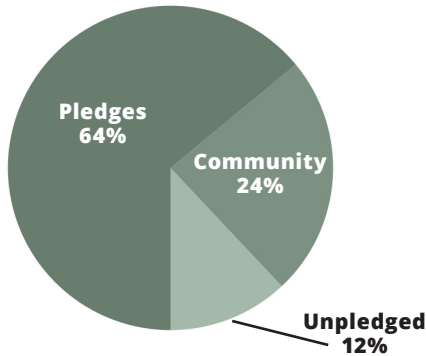

Our Expenses:

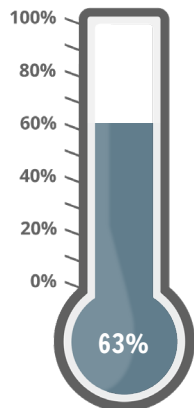


Our Giving Sources:

\$187,531 of our **\$300,000** goal has been pledged to 2025 Operating Budget. As of December 6, we've received 47 pledges representing 74 people. Last year, we received a total of 67 pledges.

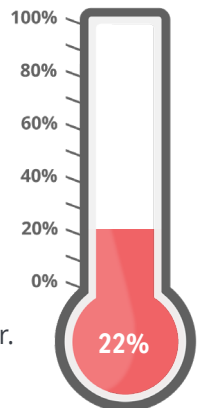

Radical inclusion, grounded in God's love for all people, is central to Allendale UMC. Our campus has become a vibrant hub for hundreds of community groups resisting hate and promoting justice, from hosting cooking classes and sewing workshops to organizing for voting rights, reproductive justice, and racial equity. Over the next few years, we aim to further this mission by building Dr. King's vision of a Beloved Community—creating a greener, safer, and more accessible campus for all.

This capital campaign, which we're calling "Hate Cannot Drive Out Hate" will fund critical improvements to advance Allendale's mission of radical hospitality. Priorities include reducing our carbon footprint, improving accessibility, renovating restrooms, weatherproofing aging facilities, and creating welcoming multi-purpose spaces. These upgrades are essential for sustaining Allendale as a home for justice, equity, and community connection. 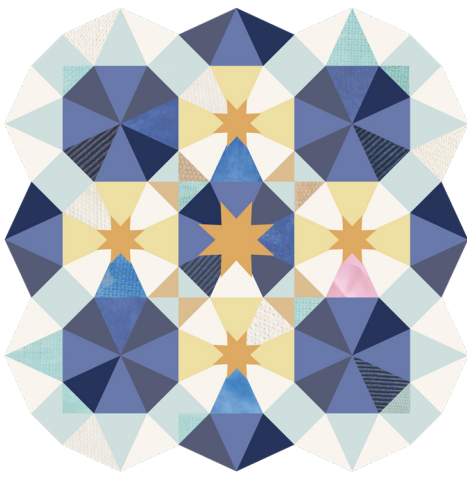
