

ISAIAH 43:1-7

God resides in the water and all areas of our natural world - including us. The water is an incarnation, a medium, a manifestation, theophany, and theologian. We cannot be a body of believers without encountering God in the water, hovering with her over the deep. Our texts call us to look out over bodies of water and remember who/whose we are. Why were we forced into the water? Why were we deprived of water? Why did we have to struggle for access to our waters? As water sustains life, we embrace water ritual to ground us in the One who bonds hydrogen to oxygen. Even if our only water is our tears, Spirit meets us there.
