

WITNESS

CANDLE OF PEACE, HOPE, AND JUSTICE:

During apartheid in South Africa, Johannesburg's Central Methodist Mission created a candle encircled in barbed wire, inspired by Amnesty International's symbol. They called it the Candle of Peace, Hope, and Justice. Each week, they lit the candle during worship, naming those harassed, imprisoned, or killed for resisting racial injustice. As they read John 1:5—"The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it"—they rededicated themselves to justice. Their actions led the government to ban their services from radio and TV.

Today, we continue our new ritual of lighting a Candle of Peace, Hope, and Justice at the start of worship, joining 25 congregations across the country in prayer for those suffering under our government's barbedwire policies—knowing that you cannot have peace and hope without justice.

This Sunday, we light the candle of Peace, Hope, and Justice for migrants for asylum seekers forced to return to a place of violence or destruction, for children and youth born in this country fearing deportation from the only home they've known, for families afraid to step outside because they know they risk arrest the moment they leave their front door, for those imprisoned at Guantanamo Bay while loved ones desperately search for them., for workers labeled criminals despite paying taxes and doing essential labor for low wages, and for faith leaders striving to make their churches places of true sanctuary from the world's cruelty and injustice.

We light this candle proclaiming that the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has never overcome the light. May Jesus strengthen us to resist evil, injustice, and oppression in whatever forms they present themselves.

LUKE 6:17-26

With the blessings often come warnings. With promises are often predictions of peril. The binary between the wicked and righteous may not always be most helpful, but it can help us remember how these parties are interrelated like predator and prey. The US executive branch has caught onto this use of binaries to express domination in their insistence on two genders. In this way, we can't read righteous and wicked as separate from one another. But if the dead can be resurrected, these positions can surely be transformed. The wicked are not exploitative by nature nor are the righteous doomed to victimhood forever. God in Her mercy intervenes on behalf of the downtrodden.
