

### **CANDLE OF PEACE, HOPE, AND JUSTICE:**


During apartheid in South Africa, Johannesburg's Central Methodist Mission created a candle encircled in barbed wire, inspired by Amnesty International's symbol. They called it the Candle of Peace, Hope, and Justice. Each week, they lit the candle during worship, naming those harassed, imprisoned, or killed for resisting racial injustice. As they read John 1:5—"The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it"—they rededicated themselves to justice. Their actions led the government to ban their services from radio and TV.

This Sunday we light the Candle of Peace, Hope, and Justice for all who stand to be squeezed by barbed-wire actions aimed at crippling the work of the National Institutes of Health: for patients who are enrolled in a clinical trial on which they have placed their hope for being healed; for adults and children whose wellbeing depends on groundbreaking research that has led to lifesaving vaccines, innovative immunotherapies, and the chemotherapy that can lead to a cure; for universities where groundbreaking research could come to a screeching halt along with the breakthrough advances ascertained in their labs; for all employees whose positions have been or are in line to be eliminated; and for all who will be impacted by these actions in ways that they cannot currently imagine.

We light this candle proclaiming that the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has never overcome the light. May Jesus strengthen us to resist evil, injustice, and oppression in whatever forms they present themselves.
